
The idea is to share a story of hope and positivity in light of the difficulties associated with BCM.

4. Put a donation button on your Facebook page.


This is an opportunity to share what matters to you with your Facebook friends. Here's how:

- 1. When you are on your Facebook page, look down at the bottom of the page to see 3 icons, "Create", "Notifications" & "More". Click "More".
- 2. You now see a list entitled "Explore". The fifth item in this list is "Fundraisers". Click "Fundraisers".
- 3. Now you have instructions "Get Started with Fundraisers". All you need to do is to follow those instructions. You need to have a goal. For example, you can set your #GivingTuesday goal to \$200.
- 4. On the next page, choose that you are raising money for a Nonprofit.
- 5. Next page, type BCM Families Foundation on the grey search bar at the top of the page.
- 6. And there we are!! BCM Families Foundation, Health. Jupiter, FL. Click that.
- 7. You can now set an amount and an ending date.

What is "GivingTuesday"?

Started in 2012, #GivingTuesday is an important day for donating to charities. In 2016, a record-breaking \$177 million dollars were donated to support online

501(c)(3) nonprofits like ours. #GivingTuesday in 2016 became the third biggest donation day of year by dollars and the second biggest donation day of year by number of donors.

Clearly, BCM Families Foundation needs to have presence and a plan for #GivingTuesday. The path to #Cure4BCM is costly –the donations and new donors to support BCM research are most urgently needed.
